**Seaview Baptist Church** gladly affirms our covenant relationship with American Baptist Churches USA.

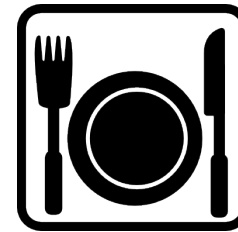
